

Uruguay, and Venezuela, besides the territory of French Guyana.




- Brazil is the largest South American country: it occupies almost half, 48% of the total area of South America.
- Brazil is the fifth largest country on the planet: 8,514,876 square kilometers.
- The Brazilian population contingent is also the largest in South America: 422.5 million inhabitants in total, and more than 212 million live in Brazil, the sixth most populous country.
- It has the largest biodiversity in the world: There are more than 116,000 animal species and over 46,000 known plant species in the country, spread across six terrestrial biomes and three large marine ecosystems.



From vibrant beachside cities to charming rural villages, Brazil has so much to offer. Its natural wonders, including the majestic Iguaçu Falls, the amazing Amazon Forest, the Pantanal wetlands, and the Atlantic Forest have been inspiring travelers from all over the globe for generations.

Brazil hosts one of the largest biodiversities in the world. The country has 62 national parks and hundreds of conservation units. Nowadays, ecotourism and responsible travel initiatives are on the rise, making it possible for more travelers to enjoy Brazil in a better way, and opening up perspectives for local communities.

It is no surprise that this huge country also keeps secrets from various cultures and ethnic groups that were formed here and, to this day, struggle to affirm and preserve their identities. Brazil is not only rich but a unique culture with very friendly people, always ready to share, teach and learn from visitors.

- Brazil has a marine coast of 3.5 million km², which includes ecosystems such as coral reefs, dunes, mangroves, lagoons, estuaries, and swamps.
- This abundant variety of life is home to more than 20% of the world's total species found on land and water.
- Brazilian biodiversity is our country's greatest wealth, so it is vital to develop responsible tourism that values and protects this enormous web of life, positively impacting the country.


LUXURY 2 (Exclusive Brazil)

NATURE AND WILDLIFE 1


HIGHLIGHTS: South Pantanal, Bonito, Iguaçu Falls & Rio de Janeiro

12 days, 11 nights

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NATURE AND WILDLIFE 2

HIGHLIGHTS: North Pantanal, Chapada dos Guimarães, Amazon & Rio de Janeiro 12 days, 11 nights

Our journey starts in North Pantanal, considered a World Natural Heritage and Biosphere Reserve by UNESCO. The Pantanal concentrates on one of the most significant diversities of fauna and flora. You can explore the most extensive floodplain globally, with 250,000 km2.

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This trip combines two unique destinations of Brazil: The Route of Emotions, one of the most breathtaking journeys in Brazil, taking you to the beautiful beaches of the state of Ceará, through the unique landscapes of the Lençóis Maranhenses national park, across the natural wonders of the Delta of the Parnaíba river between the States of Piauí and Maranhão. OFF THE BEATEN TRACK 2

HIGHLIGHTS: Iguassu, the Atlantic Rain Forest & Rio de Janeiro

On this trip, we start with the incomparable experience of visiting the Iguazu Falls, immersed in these giant waterfalls, one of the new 7 Wonders of Nature. We visit the most extensive continuous coverage of preserved Atlantic Rainforest in Brazil, the Coastal area of the Paraná State. Due to its remoteness, it has kept a natural treasure of pristine Forest, legally protected and declared a World Biosphere Reserve. The tour finishes in Rio de Janeiro, The Marvelous City, where it will be possible to do activities and excursions and has some free time to relax and enjoy these beautiful landscapes.





OFF THE BEATEN TRACK 3

HIGHLIGHTS: South Beaches and the Canyons 7 days, 6 nights

These destinations are a great stop in the South of Brazil. They bring together wild beaches, Azorean villages, typical cuisine, and breathtaking views of the canyons. Get to know unique spots to practice water sports such as kitesurf, surf, stand-up, and windsurf.

Extensions options: Praia do Rosa.

Extensions options: beaches around Salvador.







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TREKKING IN CHAPADA DIAMANTINA

A trek experience integrating amazing views, local history, and culture, the Pati Valley is considered one of Brazil's most beautiful hiking areas. Its landscape is privileged, surrounded by mountains and extensive flat areas, full of waterfalls and natural beauty, where nature seems untouched. In addition to the countless natural beauties, on this trekking, travelers have the unique opportunity to close contact with the history, habits, and local culture, contributing to the region's sustainability. This trek is also an example of safety: we work with the only agency in the Chapada Diamantina with an ISO 21.101 safety certificate exclusively for this tour.





TREKKING IN THE JOATINGA ECOLOGICAL RESERVE

A trek in the middle of the Atlantic Rain Forest Reserve by the seashore. Located between Paraty and Trindade, the access is only by boat or walking. It'll be possible to contact the Caiçara's culture (a mix of Indians and Portuguese), stay in a typical house, and learn more about their peaceful lifestyle, traditional fisherman villages, and living from nature for many years. This tour combines culture, adventure, beaches, and wildlife.





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TREKKING IN THE LENÇÓIS MARANHENSES

Trek across the sweeping white dunes of Lençóis Maranhenses National Park, with sand so soft you can make the trip in your bare feet. This vast expanse of dunes looks like an archetypical desert, but the blue and green lagoons that spring up during the rainy season let you stop for a refreshing dip along the way. At the beginning and end of your trip, explore São Luis do Maranhão, also known as "Brazilian Jamaica." Founded by the French in 1612, this vibrant city is a UNESCO World Heritage site.

UAKARI LODGE IN THE AMAZON

HIGHLIGHTS: Manaus, Tefé & Mamirauá Reserve 5 days, 4 nights

In the heart of the Amazon, a floating lodge:
Uakari, has a privileged location within the
Mamirauá Sustainable Development Reserve, the
largest area of protected floodplain forest
globally, with over 1 million hectares of rich flora
and fauna. Uakari Lodge is a pioneering initiative in
community-based tourism in Brazil and seeks to
be the best example of ecotourism in the
Amazon. It works through shared management
between Instituto Mamirauá and the
communities of Mamirauá Reserve.





AN ADVENTURE INTO THE ATLANTIC FOREST GREAT RESERVE

Starting in Curitiba, a unique train ride across Paraná's Coastal Mountain Range, in an Atlantic Forest Biosphere Reserve by UNESCO, arrives at the historic town of Morretes. In the following days, we head to Guaraqueçaba, where we visit the unmissable Salto Morato Nature Reserve accompanied by a birdwatching guide. Connection with the simple life, meetings with the local community, kayaking through the mangroves, centennial fig trees, and lots of nature are unique attractions of this itinerary. All these attractions are within this ecosystem's largest continuous area of protection. A bay amid green mountains and patches of untouched forests form indescribable landscapes that, together with the history and culture of local caiçara communities, make up a journey of unforgettable experiences.
